How to purchase MBF Prevention Education Programs:

- All *MBF Prevention Education Programs* are provided to customers via a password-protected Facilitator Portal. To purchase, begin with one or more Core Digital Curriculum:
 - MBF Child Safety Matters® K-5 Digital Bundle (or a Grade Level Curriculum if not implementing all grades)
 - MBF Teen Safety Matters® 6-8 Digital Bundle (or a Grade Level Curriculum if not implementing all grades)
 - MBF Teen Safety Matters® 9-12 Digital Bundle
- The Facilitator Portal contains access to the online Facilitator Training and the curriculum materials needed to implement the programs. This includes the Facilitator Scripts and Classroom PowerPoint Lessons, which can be printed and downloaded from the Portal. Alternatively, if you would like to purchase a Curriculum Book with the printed scripts and Facilitator Manual and/or a Flash Drive containing the curriculum lessons and other program materials, you may do so with or after your purchase of a Core Digital Curriculum .
- There are reinforcement materials that should be provided with each program, including Parent Information and Activity Sheets, Safe Adult Bookmarks, Student Coloring Posters (CSM only), and Student Resource Cards, Class Notes Sheets, and Home Learning Assignment Sheets (TSM only). All of these materials are available on the Facilitator Portal to download and print via PDFs or templates. Alternatively, should you wish to purchase these items, they are available with or after your purchase of a Core Digital Curriculum.
- Additionally, there are reinforcement materials that are recommended for reinforcing the Safety Rules with students and others. Should you wish to purchase these, they are available with or after your purchase of a Core Digital Curriculum. These include a Safety Rules Banner, Safety Rules Classroom Posters, Student Stickers (CSM only), and Student Pens (TSM only).

MBF Prevention Education Programs Terms and Conditions

MBF Prevention Education Program customers, facilitators, and other school or organization staff with access to program materials must agree to abide by the following:

- MBF Prevention Education Programs (The Programs) and all related materials are the sole property of the Monique Burr Foundation for Children (MBF) and are proprietary and under the protection of copyright laws.
- All purchases of The Programs include a 3-year license to implement The Program(s) within the purchasing school or organization's school, district, or service area and a 3-year subscription to the Facilitator Portal and Facilitator Training for the specified number of Facilitators provided with The Program purchased.
- The Facilitator Portal contains access to the Certified Facilitator Training, the most up-to-date curriculum scripts and PowerPoints, and all other needed program materials.
- Only Certified Facilitators trained by MBF may implement The Programs. **Purchasing organization must ensure all Facilitators complete training.** Purchasing schools and organizations may not train Facilitators. Additional Facilitator subscriptions may be purchased. Each additional Facilitator subscription purchased will receive an individual login to the Facilitator Portal, online Facilitator Training, and customer support.
- Additional Facilitator Portal access will expire when the purchasing school/organization's 3-year subscription expires, regardless of when the additional Facilitator subscription was purchased/added.
- Contents on the Facilitator Portal (and the Curriculum Book and Flash Drive) may be reproduced and shared within the licensed school or organization with Certified Facilitators with an active Facilitator Portal subscription only. Curriculum materials may not be shared with outside organizations.
- Program lesson materials, including curriculum scripts and PowerPoints, may not be altered without the written consent of MBF. To uphold the fidelity and efficacy of The Programs, lessons must be presented as written, in their entirety.
- Program materials may be co-branded with a school or organization's logo, website, and/or contact information as long as no MBF identifying information or logos are removed and The Program names are not altered or removed. Co-branded materials must be approved by MBF prior to use.
- Reinforcement items are an integral part of The Programs. Some reinforcement items must be used with The Program lessons (including Parent Information and Activity Sheets and Safe Adult Bookmarks). These items are available on the Facilitator Portal for download and printing or they may be purchased separately from MBF. Other reinforcement items are recommended (including Banners, Student Bookmarks, Bag Tags, Pens, Pencils, and Posters) and may be purchased from MBF. An active license/Portal subscription is required to purchase reinforcement items.
- The Programs are updated on occasion. Updated Program materials will be posted to the Facilitator Portal as they become available. Facilitators with an active Facilitator Portal subscription will be notified of updates and may access, download, and print updated materials from the Facilitator Portal. No additional purchase is necessary.
- Purchasers and Facilitators of The Programs give MBF the authorization to print/publish the name, city, and state of the purchasing organization/school.

 - In lieu of the above, a comparable combination of education and experience
 - Be comfortable presenting the scripted lessons to children and/or teens about the sensitive topics in The Programs, such as sexual abuse and human trafficking
